Summer 2013: Pond Sediment Was Tested
2013-2016: Previous Pond Cleaning Projects Were Completed
Spring 2017: Current Project Authorized
Summer 2017: Final Design Completed
Fall 2017: Bids Opened & Construction Contract Awarded

Future Timeline (approximate):

Tonight/Ongoing: Engage Adjacent Property Owners
December 2017: Contracts/Insurance/Permitting/Submittals
December 2017: City to pump down pond
Winter 2017-18: Pond Excavation Work
Spring/Summer 2018: Channel Planting & Pond Restoration Work

Approximate Scope of Work:

Winter:

- Access preparation thru lift station site
- Replacement of outlet control structure
- Excavation of pond sediment (5'-8' depth)
- Grading

Spring/Summer:

- Tree removals
- Plantings and turf restoration

Project Benefits:

- Restore pond to exceed original design capacity
- Increased treatment & flood storage
- Reduction of future storm sewer and pond maintenance costs
- Channel erosion protection
- Aesthetic improvements
